

# ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF FEES & RULES



Thank you for staying at the Douglas County Fairgrounds RV Park!

We appreciate you choosing our park for your recreational needs. The following is a list of common park policies and rules. To make changes to your reservation or for questions, please call 541-957-7010

<b>CHECK-IN TIME: 2:00PM</b> <b>Stay Extension: payment is required by 11:30AM</b>	<b>CHECK-OUT TIME: 11:00AM</b> <b>Late check-out fee is \$100. Early check-ins are subject to a fee equal to the single night reservation fee.</b>

**“First come - first served”** requires a physical presence to register for a campsite; meaning the person who is to occupy the site must be present, with their camping unit, ready to physically occupy the site.

## CAMPSITE LIMITS:

**Maximum Stay:** not to exceed 14 nights within a 30 day period.

**Campsite Capacity:** Maximum of 8 individuals may occupy one campsite unless otherwise specified by the department.

**Tents:** Tents are not allowed.

## VETERAN DISCOUNT PROGRAM:

- All qualified Veterans are eligible to receive a 10% discount on campsites
- Veteran must provide proof of status to camp host when checking in and must be physically staying in the reserved site.

## VEHICLES:

- Camping units that have to be towed must be accompanied by an operational tow vehicle.
- No unregistered or untagged, inoperable or functionally deficient vehicles or RV's are allowed in the campgrounds
- All vehicles, including bicycles and OHV's will travel and park within the designated roads
- RV's, Trailers or Vehicles may not be parked out of the established sites.
- Speed limit in parks is **10 mph**
- **Extra vehicles** (including haul trailers, passenger vehicles, etc.) are subject to per unit, per night extra fee of \$6

## BEING A GOOD NEIGHBOR:

- Discharging of firearms is prohibited at any time within the park.
- Fireworks are prohibited at all times.
- Keep your camp site neat & clean. No outside storage of trash or non-recreational personal items allowed.
- Deposit trash in the containers provided. Leave your campsite as clean as you found it.
- Recreational furniture only. No home furnishings, pools or hot tubs are allowed in the campsite.

## QUIET TIME:

- 10:00 PM to 7:00 AM
- During quiet time please be considerate of your neighbors.
- Please keep your pets quiet, do not run generators, play music, or engage in loud or disruptive behavior.

## FIRES:

- Fires are allowed in designated areas only; per fire season restrictions.
- Camp stoves may be used in established campsites.
- Firewood must be kept in a neatly stacked pile.
- Do not leave a fire or a lit portable stove unattended.

## PETS:

- Pets must be on a leach and/or under the physical control of the owner at all times.
- Please clean up after your pet.
- Never leave your pet unattended.

## CANCELLATIONS & CHANGES:

- All Reservations are final; no refunds will be given.
- A reservation may be moved one time only to date within 60 days of the original reservation.
